



Important News for all Youth Soccer Players!

Our 2009 season was a great success and we thank all of coaches, referees, volunteers, parents and players for making it a really enjoyable season.

Please find attached the youth soccer registration forms for 2010. We encourage you to register as soon as possible to ensure your child is placed on the team they would like to be on. Our policy has to be first-come-first-served as we are bound by maximum limits on squad sizes by our governing body – COYSA.

We offer programs and teams for boys and girls from Under 6 (children born in 2004) to Under 18 (children born in 1992). Boys and girls play on separate teams from Under 7 to Under 10 as “Mini” players where there are no scores kept in the games and the focus is on fun. From Under 11 to Under 18 children play “Divisional” soccer which is competitive play.

The club policy with regard to uniforms is that all players must wear a complete uniform when playing for Lake Country Soccer Club but players will buy new uniforms only when they need them. The quality of the uniforms we’re buying now means it isn’t necessary to be changing uniforms every year unless your child grows out of their uniform or loses pieces of it. If you still have your uniform from last year and it’s still usable then you don’t need to buy one. If you are a new player to our club you will need to buy a complete uniform.

You will notice in the attached registration form that you can purchase either a full uniform or pieces of a uniform depending on what you need. We keep extra uniform inventory on hand at the clubhouse to accommodate all players’ needs.

The absolute deadline for registration is January 30th 2010 at the very latest and we must have received your forms and payment by this time to be able to offer your child a place on a team for 2010. However if you wait until the last minute to register your child may not be placed on the team of their choice so we encourage you to register early.

Sadly due to declining volunteerism we are having to institute a \$20.00 volunteer bond in 2010 to help us run the club. We rely on a certain amount of volunteers every year to help us keep costs down. If you or your child coach, sit on the executive or referee you do not have to pay the volunteer fee.

If you or your child do not coach, sit on the executive or referee but are willing to volunteer 2 hours of your time at any point during the season you will be reimbursed your \$20.00. Our club administrator will organize volunteer time, please contact Crystal at admin@lakecountrysoccer.ca to discuss volunteer opportunities and tasks.

Lake Country Soccer Club also has twelve adult teams and we offer the opportunity for all of our residents to participate in Soccer at an appropriate skill level.

***U11-U18 players are classified as “Divisional” and will participate in the Kelowna Cup. Divisional players will play from April 17th-June 26th and also play from September 11th – October 17th. All Divisional players will participate in the opening jamboree at Beasley Park on April 10th where team and individual photos will be taken, as well as the Kelowna Cup finals in early October (if their team qualifies).
